A.C.T. is a UK-registered charity formed in March 1999 with the vision to relieve poverty and advance development in Africa through the education of disadvantaged fatherless children and orphans. We also support widows through training to generate income so they can sustain their families.

To date more than 600 children and 450 widows have benefited from our projects.

Core Activities

Our core activities can be summarised as follows:

- ♦ Educating disadvantaged children
- ♦ Empowering Widows through literacy and business skills training
- ♦ Enriching communities by supporting local schools and health services
- ♦ Sending out skilled volunteers to support our projects and activities.

Countries

A.C.T. is currently working in Zambia, Burkina Faso, Uganda, Tanzania, Malawi and Nigeria.
